All Abstracts (maximum 250-350 words) must be written in **English**, submitted in **one PDF file**, numbered, in correct sequence, and structured as follows:

- 1) Background/Aims** - What is the major problem that prompted the study?; **2) Methods** - How was the study performed?; **3) Results** - Most important findings? **4) Conclusion** - Most important conclusion? (Titles must be given in sentence case, not in capital or lower case only); **5) Authors** - Without titles or degrees, one forename must be given in full; **6) Affiliation** - Name and address of department(s) and institution(s) to which the work should be attributed.

*The inclusion of one table of figure (in 300dpi in CMYK-color) is a possible option.
Case reports, case studies, studies results and study protocols are accepted.*
